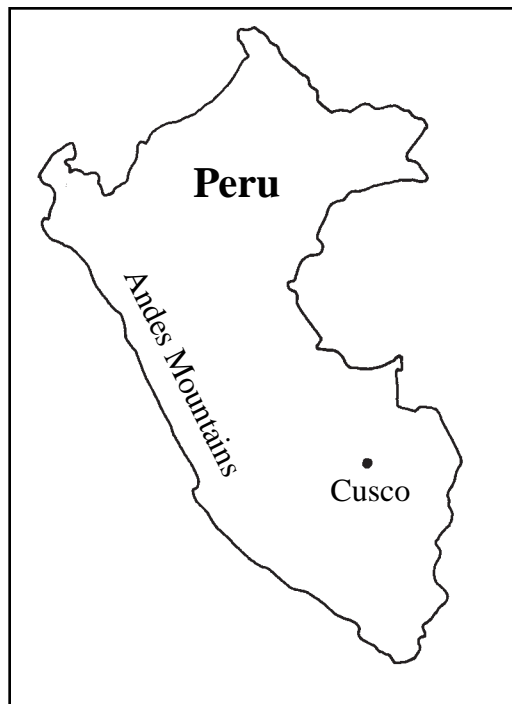
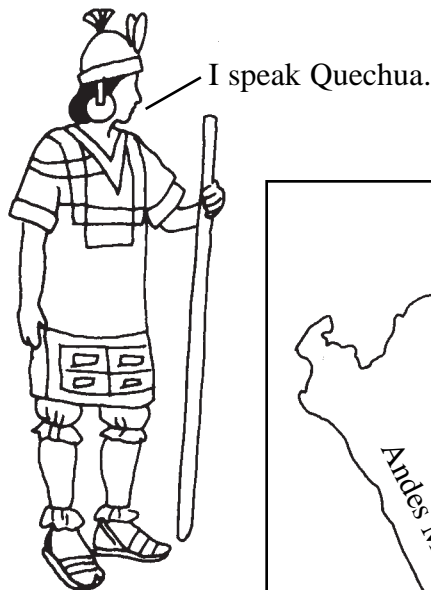
THE JOURNAL OF FRANCISCO PIZARRO
