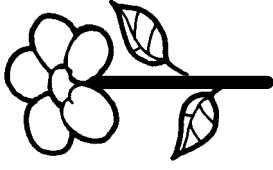


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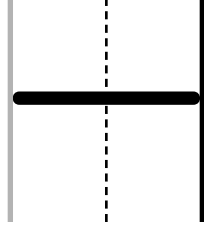
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Teaching the Letters l, i, j, g, q, and p (cont.)

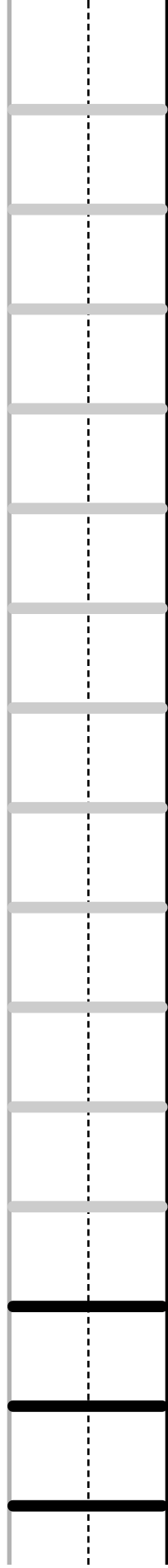


Here is a surprise! You have already made many long, straight lines.

A long straight line makes a letter of the alphabet! It is the letter l.



Practice writing the letter l here. Say the name of the letter as you write it.



Do you remember how the circle shape was exactly the same as the letter o? This straight line is exactly the same as the letter l. One is a shape and the other is a letter. But there is not any difference in the way they look, and you will make them exactly the same way.
